DogsBite.org is a national dog bite victims' group dedicated to reducing serious dog attacks. We conduct research on the growing, but underreported, public safety issue of severe and fatal dog attacks inflicted by dangerous dog breeds. Our dog bite fatality research is transparent, and our data collection method is always available online.<sup>1</sup>

DogsBite.org credentials include our statistical data cited by multiple peer-reviewed medical studies, entered into evidence in three United States District Court cases, cited by the U.S. Department of Transportation, and by our supplying the winning amicus brief<sup>2</sup> in the seminal high court case declaring pit bulls "inherently dangerous" in Maryland.<sup>3</sup>

Statistical data from DogsBite.org has exceptional credibility with court justices, medical practitioners, attorneys who champion and represent dog mauling victims, the many national, regional, and local news agencies that cite our nonprofit's data, including *Newsweek, Forbes, CBS News* and more, and of course the injured victims themselves.

#### Federal and State Courts:

Starting in 2020, multiple cities in the Midwest faced challenges to their pit bull ban ordinances. In two of those cases, the city's expert cited our dog bite fatality research.
